importance of good saddle fit. Also covering the training process to become a saddle fitter, saddle	
structure and the fitting process	
Farriery and podiatry lectures	1
Supports home study block 3	
Key learnings = the training process to become a farrier / podiatrist and the importance of good	
hoof balance – whether the horse is shod or barefoot.	
The podiatry lecture will include some elements of equine distal limb dissection.	
Dentistry lecture	1
Supports home study block 3	
Key learnings = the structure and number of equine teeth, the importance of good tooth balance	
throughout the horses mouth and the training process to become an equine dentist.
